



Child Protection PAC Endorses Blake Paulson for Minnesota House District 10B

[Child Protection PAC](#) supports and endorses Blake Paulson for the Minnesota House of Representatives District 10B in the August 9, 2022 Republican Primary.

Blake Paulson is a strong leader who is in full support of issues protecting children.

- He opposes state educational standards and American history curricula that interpret America's founding and growth only [through a lens of racial conflict](#) and that portray U.S. constitutional principles of individual rights endowed by our Creator as racist.
- He opposes [mandates to mask children](#) in schools.
- He is staunchly prolife and would support prolife legislation such as the [Heartbeat Protection bill](#).
- He opposes the graphic school [comprehensive sex education \(CSE\)](#) programs that some are attempting to mandate. CSE normalizes minors being sexually active, denies gender is based on the biology of two sexes, and teaches children as young as preschool that gender is a 'spectrum' of identities.
- He supports full curriculum transparency in the schools, available online and without cost.

Paulson's leadership is evident. As a student at the University of Minnesota in 2019, he was also an intern for the Minnesota Trump organization, enlisting other conservative students. He succeeded in obtaining the University's official recognition for a Trump-supporting student group on campus that would set up Trump-supporting tables. Here he faced intense leftist opposition, including being yelled at and spat upon. Yet he ran for and was elected to the University's student government association, there confronting the radical student activists. Blake Paulson understands conflict, and he is fearless in promoting and defending freedom.

In the Spring of 2020, he worked full time with the Trump campaign, and rose to be a regional director for mid-central Minnesota, part of which is now House District 10B.

After working on the Georgia Senate run-off election and finishing his degree, he became a Legislative Assistant for Representative Matt Grossell, author of the [Protect Minnesota Kids Act legislation](#) (PMKA), which Child Protection League has championed. This legislation would increase sentencing guidelines for people convicted of producing, trading and possessing child sexual abuse imagery. PMKA protects children by putting these predators behind bars.
